If you're travelling by train and need the bus at either end of the journey, ask for *PLUSBUS*. It's a simple, easy-to-use bus add-on to your rail ticket and lets you travel on most buses within the local *PLUSBUS* area as many times as you like.

It's quicker and cheaper than stopping to buy tickets for each leg of your journey.

Buy your *PLUSBUS* ticket in advance from any staffed rail station. No more queues, simply show your ticket on the bus and off you go!



How does it work?

The cost of the *PLUSBUS* ticket will be the cost of the rail ticket plus an additional amount for each day of bus travel. It's simple and saves you money compared to the cost of multiple bus journeys.

Buy your ticket in advance, and then you can use it to catch a bus to the station to begin your journey.

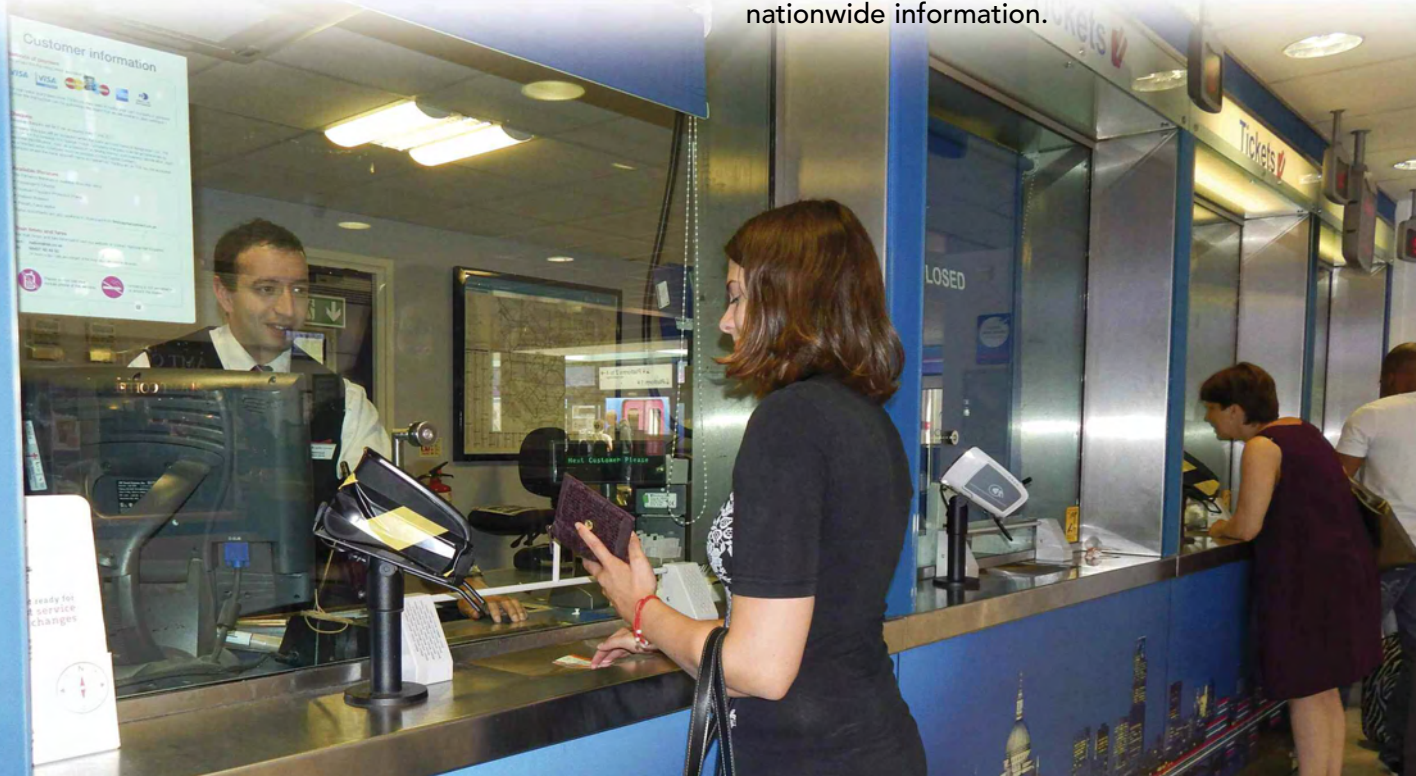
PLUSBUS can be purchased with Single, Day Return, all types of period returns and rail season tickets. All season tickets with *PLUSBUS* allow unlimited bus travel in the local area for the whole period of your rail ticket.

However, *PLUSBUS* tickets can't be bought with rail tickets for train journeys which are entirely within one *PLUSBUS* area. Check that you can use *PLUSBUS* before you travel by visiting www.intalink.org.uk.

Where can I buy one?

You can buy *PLUSBUS* at any staffed rail station as an add-on to any rail journey to or from participating stations. You can also purchase *PLUSBUS* day tickets on-line at www.thameslinkrailway.com.

You can check to see which stations are included by visiting www.plusbus.info for nationwide information.



Throughout the pages of this leaflet you will find barcodes, known as QR Codes, as per the example below for St Albans Railway Station.

Scan this picture with your mobile phone to get bus departure information on your Internet browser, for bus stops at and around the railway station.

This display will refresh every 30 seconds and can be accessed whenever you wish if you bookmark it.

Download a free QR Code Reader on your phone by searching for "**QR Code Reader**". **Intalink** does not charge you to use this service but your mobile operator may charge you to access the Internet on your phone.

If you wish to access this information on a personal computer you can also type in the URL at the top of the image (see below for example).

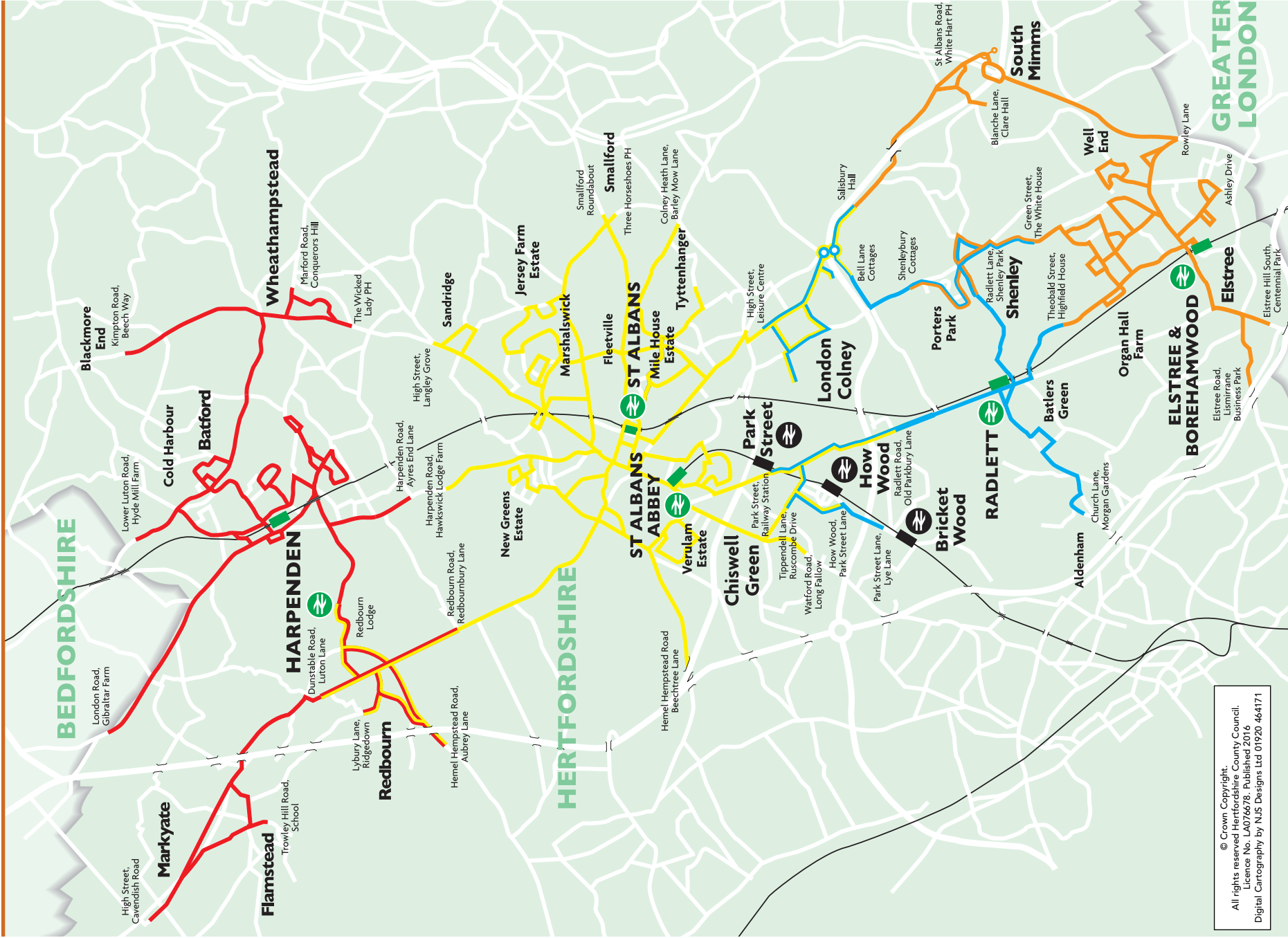

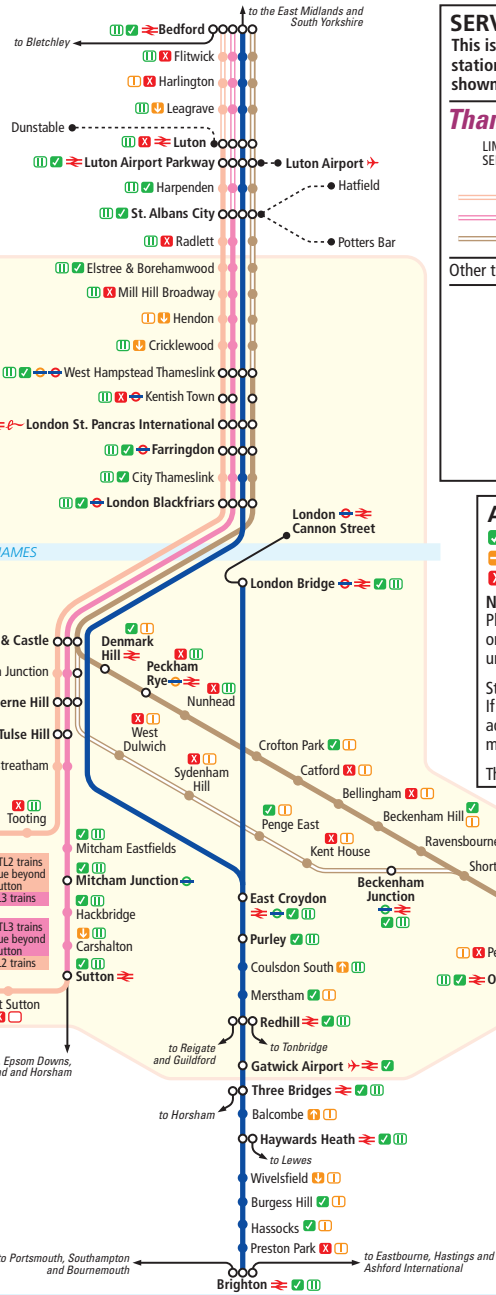
